Much like my daughter's character, this Cabernet Sauvignon is bold and speaks for itself. It is quite popular in my hometown of Jezzine in Southern Lebanon since the locals appreciate it to weather the harsh winters. – Captain Habib Karam

<b>Grape Variety</b>	Cabernet Sauvignon
<b>Appellation</b>	Jezzine, Southern Lebanon
<b>Fermentation</b>	100% in stainless steel
<b>Maturation</b>	Aged in oak barrels for 12 months. 100% new French oak.
<b>Serving</b>	Best served at 17°C.
<b>Decanting</b>	Decant for one hour prior to savoring.

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**Winemaking & Tasting Notes** Grown on the hot, dry, and gravelly soil of the Jezzine mountain ridge slopes, towering at 1,300-meter altitude; this handpicked Cabernet Sauvignon has been vinified with proud ancestral skill, giving it a peppery rich bouquet of ripe fruits and chocolate aromas. Its rounded tannins and balanced structure are a prelude to its excellent length. This complex, opaque and harmonious wine is suitable for ageing or present enjoyment.

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**Food Pairing** Steak tartar, medium-rare steak, lamb dishes and hard cheeses.
